Short Biography

Arie M. C. A. Koster (1973) is a Professor of Mathematics at RWTH Aachen University. He was a senior researcher with the Department of Optimization at Zuse Institute Berlin and an Assistant Professor at Warwick Business School and the Centre for Discrete Mathematics and its Applications of the University of Warwick, United Kingdom, before joining RWTH Aachen University in 2009. His research interests include integer linear programming, robust optimization, algorithmic graph theory, and network optimization. He has published over 100 research papers and is an associate editor of both INFORMS Journal of Computing and the Asia-Pacific Journal of Operational Research. Recently, he has been studying virtual network embedding problems, flexgrid optical networks and dayahead energy supply, all under demand uncertainty.
