Gerhard Reinelt studied Computer Science and Operations Research at the University of Bonn. Took a Doctoral degree in Mathematics, University of Augsburg in 1991. First professor position in Mathematics in 1992 at Heidelberg University. Professor for Computer Science in Heidelberg since 1999. Member of the Heidelberg Graduate School of "Mathematical and Computational Methods for the Sciences" and the Research Training Group "Spatio/Temporal Graphical Models and Applications in Image Analysis". He is one of the directors of the Interdisciplinary Center for Scientific Computing (IWR). His main research area of interest is development and implementation of effective algorithms for solving hard combinatorial optimization problems to proven optimality.
